Subject: Information regarding the course provider “Common Purpose”

Date Released: 3 April 2009

Summary of request: The enquirer requested the names of staff and money paid to Common Purpose course from 2000

Information released:

1. Name all employees who have attended a Common Purpose course?

From our records we can determine that two employees attended the Navigator Programme run by Common Purpose in each of the years 2003 and 2004.

I am unable to provide you with the names of those employees that attended these courses as this would be personal information and as such would be exempt under section 40 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 as disclosure would directly contravene the data protection principles.

2. How much money has been paid to this organisation?

3. Please provide copies of invoices / receipts.

I have attached scanned copies of the relevant invoices which total £14,100. As explained above, I have redacted the names of the individuals concerned and also redacted the invoice number and BACS details because this information would be exempt under section 41 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 as it is deemed to be information provided in confidence to Companies House by the third party.

I must apologise for the quality of the scanned image. If you would like to provide me with an address I will arrange for hard copies of these invoices to be sent to you.

As we do not keep financial records for longer than 6 years, I cannot provide any information before 2002 though I can confirm that this is all the information that we currently hold regarding this company.
